### QUESTIONS

1. When you think of your “place in the world” what is the first image that you have – is it the earth from space, or your bedroom, or what?
2. Give “your place” a name – is it “home”, or your room, your town, your country?
3. Why do you think that place, and not somewhere larger (or smaller) is the one where you feel you belong?
4. If you could give your place a name, what would you call it?
5. When you think of your address, which part of it do you think is the most important?
6. Does your address have a house name? Street name? Suburb name? Town name? Do you know where any of these names came from?
7. Pick one name from your address and find out where it came from – Google, the local library, the local council might all have the answers.
